### PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

### The holder has acquired general skills relating to:

Selecting the most suitable materials for the production of the project to hand, selecting the equipment to be used and the most appropriate way of using it for each specific job, and correctly executing the production and finishing techniques that form the basis of this artisanal craft, among others.

The teaching provided in this cycle is intended to achieve the training of specialists in the different artisanal processes used to manufacture mats, carpets and baskets, all highly traditional, with such vegetable fibres as esparto grass, sisal, hemp, jute and albardine.

Within this framework, each PROFESSIONAL MODULE includes objectives leading to the following LEARNING RESULTS that the holder acquires.

## "Dibujo" (drawing)

The title holder:

- Develops his or her creativity, aesthetic sensitivity and their expressive and communicative capacity.
- Captures an image of his or her surrounding objects and is able to represent and reproduce that image graphically using different plastic and technical methods.
- Creates and interprets sketches, drawings and blueprints and knows and interprets the rules and other graphic information related to the artistic-artisanal and ornamental creation appropriate to this speciality, in a two-dimensional representation thereof.

### "Color" (colour)

The title holder:

- Possesses general knowledge of colour and chromatic composition.
- Knows the basic factors and relationships that intervene in chromatic behaviour and in the perception of colour.
- Uses the various techniques and procedures correctly.
- Develops his or her creative ability and artistic sensitivity through specific work.

# "Historia de la Cultura y del Arte: textiles artísticos" (history of culture and art: artistic textiles)

The title holder:

- Attains the necessary knowledge of major past and present cultural and artistic cycles.
- Develops his or her intellectual personality and completes their artistic and technical training.
- Knows the essential aspects of the ideological, political, economic, social and aesthetic context in which the textile arts have been generated throughout History with special reference to artistic esparto grass weaving.

### "Taller de espartería artística" (artistic esparto grass weaving workshop)

The title holder:

- Possesses the knowledge, skills and abilities that allow him or her to correctly execute the specific techniques of this speciality, paying special attention to the learning of the artisanal techniques that are traditionally rooted in the geographical environment of educational centres.
- Uses the workshop materials and equipment properly.
- Knows the different hard fibre techniques and materials, assessing their expressive possibilities.
- Knows the traditional artisanal techniques, particularly those that have their roots in the geographical environment.
- Develops his or her creativity and artistic sense.

### "Formación y Orientación Laboral" (training and career guidance)

The title holder:

- Knows the legal working framework and the rights and obligations that derive from labour relations.
- Possesses the economic, commercial and social knowledge that makes it possible to administer and run a small and medium-sized company, or to work as a self-employed professional.
- Possesses specific knowledge as to the labour market access mechanisms and selection systems, and the skills that make it easier to find work.
- Knows the institutional bodies, both national and community, that help labour insertion and the services that provide economic aid and subsidies for entrepreneurial initiatives and self-employment.
- Knows the legal, corporate and professional instruments specific to the speciality.

#### RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The holder of a Diploma of Education in Plastic Arts and Design in Artistic Esparto Grass Weaving carries out his or her professional activity in companies in the manufacturing sector, and in others within other industrial production sectors that require the services of such professionals given that they use among their components elements specific to or related to the production of vegetable fibres and esparto grass; in workshops of an artisanal or artistic nature, whether public or private, small, medium-sized or large, related to the professional field relating to the production of vegetable fibres and esparto grass; as a freelance professional or an associate in a cooperative; under the direction of more senior technicians or others from other academic fields, carrying out projects that use components from the professional field relating to such manufacturing; in providing consultation services to independent professionals or artists; or in carrying out projects of an artistic nature that they themselves, other graduates or artists have created.

### **OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE**

Name and status of the body awarding the certificate: The Ministerio de Educación, Cultura y Deporte (the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport) or the Autonomous Communities in the area of their own administrative responsibility. The degree has academic and professional effects that are valid throughout the entire State.

Official duration of the Diploma: 1,600 hours.

Level of the certificate (national or international).

- NATIONAL: Post-compulsory secondary education.
- INTERNATIONAL:
  - Level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED3).
  - Level ---- of the European Qualifications Framework (EQF----).

**Entry requirements:** A Graduate Degree in Secondary Education, or a Certificate of having passed the corresponding entrance test.

Access to the next level of education or training: Will be able to access Higher Level Training Cycles, subject to passing an entrance test.

Legal basis. Rules and regulations on which the Diploma is based:

 Minimum teaching requirements established by the State: Royal Decree 1738/1998, of 31 July, which establishes the several diplomas of Education in Plastic Arts and Design, which belong to the professional family of Artistic Textiles, and approves the corresponding minimum education requirements.

**Explanatory note:** This document is intended as supplementary information to the Diploma in question, but on its own it does not have any legal validity. It may be accompanied by an Annex I which the corresponding Autonomous Community shall fill in.
