PROFILE OF SKILLS AND COMPETENCES

The holder has acquired general skills relating to:

The creation, drawing, photomechanics, stencilling, printing, handling, packaging, etc., skills which make this cycle especially rich in professional possibilities; with its double artistic and professional facets, meets the existing demand in society.

The Artistic Silkscreen Printing training cycle prepares professionals who have mastered silkscreen printing in all its variants, coordinating and directing the process of marking, and participating in all phases of silkscreen creation and production.

Within this framework, each PROFESSIONAL MODULE includes objectives leading to the following LEARNING RESULTS that the holder acquires.

“Técnicas de Expresión Gráfica” (techniques of graphic expression)

The title holder:

- Develops his or her aesthetic sensitivity by learning to capture an image of his or her surrounding objects and is able to represent and reproduce that image graphically using different plastic and technical methods approved for this speciality.
- Attains the artistic experience needed to interpret sketches, drawings and plans, guidelines and other graphic information related to the implementation of and resources for the artistic, artisan and ornamental production of two-dimensional representation.

“Historia de la Cultura y del Arte: Artes del Libro” (history of culture and art: book arts)

The title holder:

- Possesses a more global vision of the professional environment, through knowledge of the history of Artistic Silkscreen Printing, its evolution and ongoing applications - all in the general context of the history of art and graphic reproduction media.

“Taller de Técnica Serigráfica” (workshop on silkscreen printing technique)

The title holder:

- Visually interprets an original, assessing its tonal and chromatic balance.
- Selects the correct media and inks.

- Prepares matrices
- Carries out the printing.
- Possesses a strict sense of order and neatness.

“Formación y Orientación Laboral” (training and career guidance)

The title holder:

- Knows the legal working framework and the rights and obligations that derive from labour relations.
- Possesses the economic, commercial and social knowledge that makes it possible to administer and run a small and medium-sized company, or to work as a self-employed professional.
- Possesses specific knowledge as to the labour market access mechanisms and selection systems, and the skills that make it easier to find work.
- Knows the institutional bodies, both national and community, that help labour insertion and the services that provide economic aid and subsidies for entrepreneurial initiatives and self-employment.
- Knows the legal, corporate and professional instruments specific to the speciality.

RANGE OF OCCUPATIONS ACCESSIBLE TO THE HOLDER OF THE CERTIFICATE

The holder of a Diploma of Education in Plastic Arts and Design in Artistic Silkscreen Printing carries out his or her professional activity in companies dedicated to silkscreen printing, whether they are suppliers or their specific activity is that of silkscreen printing or they use the same in any of their marking or signage departments, etc. Their training will also allow them to develop their career within workshops dedicated to the embossing of graphic work. He or she may also work as an independent professional or an associate in a cooperative.

The type of companies to which the student may gain entry is equally as broad as the highly diverse world of silkscreen printing:

- Supplies.
- Signage.
- Advertising billboards.
- Ceramic decals.
- Graphic work.
- Marking of textiles.
- Commercial stickers.
- Posters.
- Advertising articles.
- Labelling, etc.

OFFICIAL BASIS OF THE CERTIFICATE

Name and status of the body awarding the certificate: The Ministerio de Educación, Cultura y Deporte (the Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport) or the Autonomous Communities in the area of their own administrative responsibility. The degree has academic and professional effects that are valid throughout the entire State.

Official duration of the Diploma: 950 hours.

Level of the certificate (national or international).

- NATIONAL: Post-compulsory secondary education.
- INTERNATIONAL:
 - Level 3 of the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED3).
 - Level ----- of the European Qualifications Framework (EQF-----).

Entry requirements: A Graduate Degree in Secondary Education, or a Certificate of having passed the corresponding entrance test.

Access to the next level of education or training: Will be able to access Higher Level Training Cycles, subject to passing an entrance test.

Legal basis. Rules and regulations on which the Diploma is based:

- Minimum teaching requirements established by the State: Royal Decree 1387/1995, of 4 August, which establishes the diplomas of Higher Education in Plastic Arts and Design in Artistic Silkscreen Printing and in Chalcographic Engraving, which belong to the professional family of Art Applied to Books, and approves the corresponding minimum education requirements.

Explanatory note: This document is intended as supplementary information to the Diploma in question, but on its own it does not have any legal validity. It may be accompanied by an Annex I which the corresponding Autonomous Community shall fill in.
